

# Embedding a Gcast Podcast into a Blog or Webpage

## Step 1: Record and Save Audio

- Use recording software such as Audacity (<http://audacity.sourceforge.net/>)
- Export to MP3 file format


## Step 2: Create a Gcast account

- Go to <http://www.gcast.com/user>
- Follow steps to create your account.

## Step 3: Upload Audio Files

### 1 Add Audio to Your Podcast

- ▶ **By Phone:** [Set your Phone and PIN here](#) then call 1-888-65-GCAST (888-654-2278). [international option](#)
- ▶ **From your computer:** [Upload new audio files](#)
- ▶ **From emerging artists:** [Find pod-safe music](#) at [GarageBand](#) and click "Add to playlist" for each song you like.

- Under Add Audio to Your Podcast select [Upload new audio files](#).
- Type in a title for the file.
- Click Browse to find the file on your computer.
- Click

## Step 4: Copy HTML Code

- Under Listen to Your Podcast click on your podcast's name
- Click [Love this podcast? Add it to your blog or MySpace!](#)
- Select your color theme and playback options.
- Under Step 4, click [Copy Code to Clipboard](#)

## Step 5: Pasting HTML Code

- Log into your Blog, Web Page, MySpace, etc.
- You are going to need to access the HTML view of your application. In most blogs, click on "Plain Text/HTML Editor" or "Edit HTML."
- Paste the HTML code you copied in Step 4 into the HTML editor.
- **Save** you post.
