

Furl is a free service that saves a personal copy of any page you find on the Web, and lets you find it again instantly by searching your archive of pages.

**Step 1: Go to Furl's Web Page:** <http://www.furl.net>, and create a free account.

**Step 2: Make a Furl button on your browser's Links Bar**

- While Logged in, go to the [My Tools Tab](#)
- Right Click on (non-popup version [Furl No-pop](#) )
- Select **Add to Favorites** (click **OK** on the warning message)
- Click the Links folder (or browse to where you want the link to go) and click **OK**

**Step 3: Start Archiving**

- Find a website you want to bookmark
- Click your **Furl It** button
- Add or Edit Title
- Select a Topic or create Topic
- Fill in any additional information you want
- Click **Save**

**Step 4: Sharing**

- Share your Furl URL:

  - Copy Source Code and paste into web page editor
